

1.	<b>adyton</b>	a ritual bath for purification
2.	<b>amphora</b>	container for liquids e.g. wine
3.	<b>anachronism</b>	something that does not fit with its time
4.	<b>ashlar</b>	precisely cut and well-finished stone
5.	<b>baetyl</b>	a rock over which libation offerings were poured, the rock might represent a god
6.	<b>bothros</b>	a pit used for offerings
7.	<b>chthonic</b>	relating to the interior of the soil, underground, the underworld
8.	<b>cist</b>	a cavity in the ground lined with stone
9.	<b>cistern</b>	a reservoir or water storage area
10.	<b>consort</b>	partner, companion, spouse
11.	<b>cremation</b>	the burning of the body of a deceased person
12.	<b>deity</b>	a god or goddess
13.	<b>dromos</b>	a path leading into a Mycenaean style tholos tomb
14.	<b>epiphany</b>	the showing, appearance or revelation of a god's presence
15.	<b>faience</b>	a non-ceramic glass-like substance
16.	<b>fresco</b>	painting on plaster while it is still wet or fresh
17.	<b>frieze</b>	a decorative band
18.	<b>griffin</b>	a monster with the head and wings of an eagle and the body of a lion
19.	<b>hieroglyph</b>	a figure of an animal or thing standing for a word, a syllable or a sound
20.	<b>horns of consecration</b>	a stylized and symbolic representation of the horns of a bull
21.	<b>inhumation</b>	burial in the ground
22.	<b>kanthros</b>	a drinking vessel with two elaborate handles
23.	<b>Keftiu</b>	name used in Egypt most probably to signify Cretans
24.	<b>kernos</b>	flat offering tables with small depressions for cups
25.	<b>kouloura</b>	a round storage pit or silo dug into the ground
26.	<b>kylix</b>	a shallow drinking cup with two handles
