
1. AusIndustry	an independent body established by the Australian government to assist with the administration of its innovation and venture capital programs
2. The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission	an independent authority, aiming to ensure that individuals and businesses comply with the Commonwealth competition, fair trading and consumer protection laws
3. australiandesign.org	an initiative of the Australian Design Awards aimed at supporting, promoting and enriching the Australian industrial design community
4. Australian Securities and Investments Commission	one of Australia's corporate, market and financial services regulators, ensuring that financial markets are fair and transparent
5. Business.gov	deals with businesses at the start-up stage and provides advice on business structure, marketing plans and export strategies
6. The Council of Small Business of Australia	the peak body of small business organisations; provides support packages to small businesses
7. Innovation Australia	a board that supports programs involving innovations that are developing renewable energy and green technologies
8. IP Australia	the Australian Government agency responsible for intellectual property including administering patents, trademarks and plant breeder's rights
9. NRMA Motoring & Services	one of many non-government agencies prepared to commit to innovation and new products e.g. the Optalert technology
10. Standards Australia	a regulatory body that establishes criteria that all products and processes are required to work towards
