| 1. <b>bill of rights</b>     | a statement of basic human rights and privileges  |
| 2. <b>implied rights</b>     | civil and political rights that can be inferred from the Constitution, rather than being expressly stated |
| 3. <b>political autonomy</b> | self-determination, independence  |
| 4. <b>responsibilities</b>   | legal or moral obligations to others  |
| 5. <b>rights</b>             | legal or moral entitlements or permissions  |
| 6. <b>self-determination</b> | the right to determine one's own acts without external influence  |
| 7. <b>self-executing</b>     | the idea that a treaty becomes binding as soon as the treaty has been ratified                            |
| 8. <b>tortious</b>           | wrongful; constituting a tort or breach of duty to others   |
