3. <b>bishop</b>	a member of the highest rank of clergy, responsible for leading a Christian community	23. <b>kinship</b>	the claiming of a blood or spiritual family connection

10. <b>diocese</b>	a subdivision of the church under the care of a bishop		
11. <b>dispossess</b>	to deprive someone of their possessions		
12. <b>doctrines</b>	beliefs that are set forth by an authority as binding on all members		
13. <b>dogma</b>	a principle, especially as laid down by the authority of a church		
14. <b>ecumenism</b>	the movement towards unity of all the Christian churches		
15. <b>enlightenment</b>	an 18th century European movement which celebrated science and philosophy over religion and superstition		
16. <b>esoteric</b>	a philosophy or belief meant only for the initiated
