2.	conciliation	a method of legal dispute resolution involving a third party who helps the parties to reach agreement
3.	consent	free and voluntary agreement by a rational person who is able to understand and make a decision about the matter to which he or she agrees
4.	contempt of court	words or actions that show a disregard for the authority of the court or interfere with its powers
5.	dispossession	the removal or expulsion of people from their traditional lands
6.	express consent	consent given directly, either oral or written
7.	in camera	privately; only specified persons such as the judge can be present during the testimony or proceeding
8.	martial law	military government and laws imposed on civilian society, which overrides civil law
9.	native title	the right of indigenous people to their traditional lands
10.	nomadic	people who tend to travel and change settlements frequently
11.	pastoralists	farmers raising sheep or cattle, usually on large areas of land
12.	sexual assault	a general term for criminal offences involving unwanted sexual contact
13.	sponsorship	the support of an individual, event, or organisation financially or through the provision of products and services
14.	tort law	the body of law that deals with civil wrongs including negligence, defamation, trespass and nuisance
15.	trespass to the person	a tort involving direct contact with a person's body without that person's consent
16.	vicarious liability	the legal liability imposed on one person or agent (e.g. an employer) for the wrong acts of another
